## INTRODUCTION

We are pleased to showcase our new partnerships to race in 2023, which you will see from the following pages are all exciting looking colts. We have bought five yearlings from the major UK and Irish auctions. KVT has always used trainers at the top of their game and our new recruits will in the capable hands of the familiar Andrew Balding, Clive Cox, Charlie Hills, Charlie and Mark Johnston and William Knight.

What a year KVT Horses, your horses, have had on the track. A record number of wins (15), a record strike-rate (16%) and record prizemoney (£580,000+), including plenty of Dubai Dirhams. Eight individual winners from 13 runners and 33% achieving a rating in the 90's, with two in the 100's. KVT has certainly punched well above it's weight this term.

The charge has been led by our admirable string of older horses, Sir Busker being the flag bearer. He is now our record prizemoney earner (£570,000 to date) eclipsing former stars Tullius and Magical Memory. This season he won the York Stakes (Group 2) and he chased home the world's top horse, Baaeed, three times. Five of his eight runs were in Group 1 company and he won prizemoney in seven races.

Big, improved performances have come from Dual Identity, now rated 95, who was an unlucky third in his most recent start in the famous Cambridgeshire at Newmarket. He is a highly progressive gelding who will give his owners plenty of special days next year. Equality landed a valuable sprint at Haydock and on his day is an extremely fast and talented gelding. Now rated 104, he is a sprinter on an upward curve who will now step up into Stakes Races. Both Carolus Magnus and Dance Fever have run some creditable races in defeat and both have won nearly £20,000 in owners prizemoney this season.

Although perhaps no superstars amongst them our three-year-old crop have had a stellar campaign collectively winning nine races. Bunker Bay hit the cross bar a few times and looks a horse to get better with another winter on his back. Cabinet Maker achieved three victories and both Regal Envoy and Fast Forward were dual winners. Attache won and was placed in most of his other starts. The majority of this cohort will race for different owners next year and we wish them well.

Chartwell House is the current stand-out amongst our two-year-old's, winning at Epsom and pocketing a £20,000 Book 1 Bonus. Snuggle had some decent form before a break; he will come back stronger next year. The others have yet to get rolling yet, but patient tactics are usually rewarded and trainers remain enthusiastic.

We again acknowledge and thank our talented trainers and their wives for their wonderful hospitality during the season. All our planned visits and lunches happened without the drama of the covid years, and we enjoyed seeing many old and new faces. Special thanks to Newsells Park Stud for showing us their yearlings and mares after an enjoyable lunch at Banyers House, owned by our sponsors Oakman Group PLC.

2022 saw our first foray into the dual purpose arena. We are looking to quietly expand this arm as some of you are keen on National Hunt. We have recently purchased Gamaret, an exciting dual winner in the Venetia Williams yard. We fully appreciate that KVT's roots are on the flat and this is very much our continued focus, but for those up for some Winter fun we aspire to provide it.

KVT, the racing community, the country and the world were deeply saddened to learn of the recent passing of The Queen. Horse racing has lost its dearest supporter. Royal Ascot, our favourite meeting, will not seem the same without her.

With fluctuating exchange rates and a strong global desire for bloodstock the Autumn yearling sales have again produced some amazing results for vendors and much hard work for buyers. While retaining our strict criteria Luke has put in the leg work again for which we thank him. We hope our yearling class of 2022 will be lucky for you.

## THE ANDREW BALDING SYNDICATE

### Fast Company ex The Singing Hills colt

We bought this son of the late Fast Company for €58,000 at the Tattersalls Ireland September Yearling Sale, where we had previously purchased his paternal half-brother Flashcard. Sir Busker was also bought there, and shares his breeder/vendor, John Foley of Ballyvolane Stud, with our new colt. There was a real sense of *deja vu* when we bought this colt.

This colt is the first foal from the unraced Nathaniel mare, The Singing Hills. Nathaniel is an exceptionally well-bred horse and promising broodmare sire. The Singing Hills is a daughter of the Fred Darling (Group 3) runner-up Glen Rosie, and a half-sister to both the Listed-winning Kings Quay and the Listed-placed Fastback. Other notable horses in this pedigree include The Revenant (a recent QEII winner) and Hazel Lavery.

He is eligible for the €300,000 Tattersalls Ireland Super Auction Stakes at the Curragh in September 2023, a race in which Flashcard was second in 2018.

Luke Lillingston commented: *"When Sam and I collaborated with the Balding team at Fairyhouse we all agreed this colt had a "must have" sticker on him. We were therefore especially thrilled to secure him, and within budget. This powerful yet free moving colt, is a lovely bay colour by a stallion who is increasingly missed. His family is choc full of high-class winners with every chance he can enhance his own pedigree. He's the real deal!"*

## THE CLIVE COX SYNDICATE

### El Kabeir ex Sweet Dragon Fly colt

This colt looks a precocious sort. He is by the multiple US Graded Stakes winner El Kabeir, a son of the top class and much missed stallion Scat Daddy who shares his sireline with Justify and Caravaggio.

The dam, Sweet Dragon Fly, won twice in the UK and achieved a rating of 87 before being transferred to the US where she gained 'Black-Type' in California. She is a daughter of the diminutive but very fast Sweet Cecily, who won the Bosra Sham Stakes (Listed) as a two-year-old. Sweet Dragon Fly's first foal, Runaholic, is a two-year-old full-brother to our colt and has already finished runner-up in three Novice races and is currently rated 80.

He was bought for £45,000 at the Doncaster Premier Yearling Sale which makes him eligible for the 2023 Goffs UK Premier Yearling Stakes at York in August.

Luke Lillingston commented: *"For many years Coolmore's top sire line was Galileo; now it's Scat Daddy. El Kabeir is his promising young son whose best progeny include Andrew Balding's high class pair Masekala and Harrow. This colt looks properly fast, not surprising given his broodmare sires are notable speed influences, Oasis Dream and Kodiak. Our opinion of him was rubber stamped by Clive Cox and I believe he represented very good value at a strong Doncaster yearling sale."*

### Dark Angel ex Last Bid colt

We purchased this colt for €60,000 at the Goffs Orby Yearling Sale which makes him eligible for the 2023 Goffs Million Sales Race at the Curragh next September, a race won this year by Charlie Hills. KVT was founded in the late 80's to try to win the inaugural Cartier Millions Sales Races at Phoenix Park and, nearly 35 years on, our ethos remains to target these valuable sales race where we can.



Dark Angel is one of Europe's leading sires and a consistent source of top class horses including, of course, the Charlie Hills-trained Champion Sprinter Battaash. The whole sireline has thrived at Faringdon Place with Dark Angel's grandsire, Royal Applause, trained by Barry as well as his paternal half-brother Equiano, the father of Equality.

This colt is the fifth product of the Dark Angel / Last Bid mating, unsurprising given the breeders' family stands Dark Angel at their Yeomanstown Stud. The mating has proved hugely successful with all four of her runners winning and running to a high level, including the Listed-placed pair of San Andreas and Maggies Angel.

Luke Lillingston commented: *"Dark Angel has become synonymous with the Hills family. Barry trained him for his successful two-year-old career culminating in a brilliant Middle Park victory. This very attractive colt is a full-brother to four winners, two of them gaining black-type. We all know that nothing is guaranteed in racing but all of this makes for a highly appealing bet."*

## THE CHARLIE AND MARK JOHNSTON SYNDICATE

### Advertise ex Sahara Sky colt

This colt is from the first crop of the triple Group 1 winner Advertise, a fast son of Showcasing who won the Phoenix Stakes aged two and the Commonwealth Cup and Prix Maurice du Gheest as a three-year-old. Showcasing has made a promising start as a sire of sires and with Pivotal on his dams side, there is every chance Advertise will cut the mustard as a stallion.



The dam, Sahara Sky, is an unraced half-sister to the Champion three-year-old Sprinter Owington. She has produced five winners to date, including the Group 1-winning two-year-old Dick Whittington, who also won the Phoenix Stakes. She has also produced the 103-rated Winning Ways and the 93-rated Sign From Heaven.

This colt will be trained by Charlie and Mark Johnston, who loved him, and felt he was an ideal sort for the Tattersalls Book 1 Bonus. The Johnston family record of winning Tattersalls Book 1 Bonuses has been surpassed only by Charlie Appleby and Aiden O'Brien, but the average purchase price of their winners is around 10-times that of the Johnstons.

Luke Lillingston purchased this colt for 62,000gns and commented: *"This horse has the most fantastic shape and physique, built like the proverbial... and so he should be by one of the fastest and most precocious colts of his generation and a half brother to a Group 1-winning sprinting two-year-old. With his broodmare sires being Pivotal and Mr Prospector, two hugely influential sires on either side of the Atlantic, Advertise has a license to be a decent stallion. Our hopes are that a Book 1 Bonus will be just a step along the way to becoming a proper speedster in the next few years."*

He is by the seven time Group 1 winning globetrotter Highland Reel, who interestingly, also won a Group 2 as a two-year-old at Glorious Goodwood. His first crop are now three-year-olds and they include our colt's highly promising full-brother Inverness, already rated 94.

The dam, Four Eleven, won in her native USA and is by the outstanding broodmare sire Arch. She has produced three winners to date including the useful Glen Again and L'Aigle, as well as the aforementioned Inverness. She is a half-sister to the Prix des Reservoirs (Group 3) winner Summertime Legacy, who is the dam of the Criterium de Saint-Cloud (Group 1) winner Mandaeen and the Prix Saint-Alary (Group 1) heroine Wavering. This is also the family of the very fast and precocious Earthlight.

Luke Lillingston commented: *"Highland Reel earned £7½ million, including 7 Group 1s. This colt's broodmare sire Arch is one of my favourite broodmare sires anywhere, his second dam is by the outstanding El Gran Senor. His third dam bred Derby winner Golden Fleece. This could be KVT's shot at the big time especially considering his full-brother Inverness is so promising and progressive. If you like middle distance or staying horses this handsome horse is definitely one to get into."*
